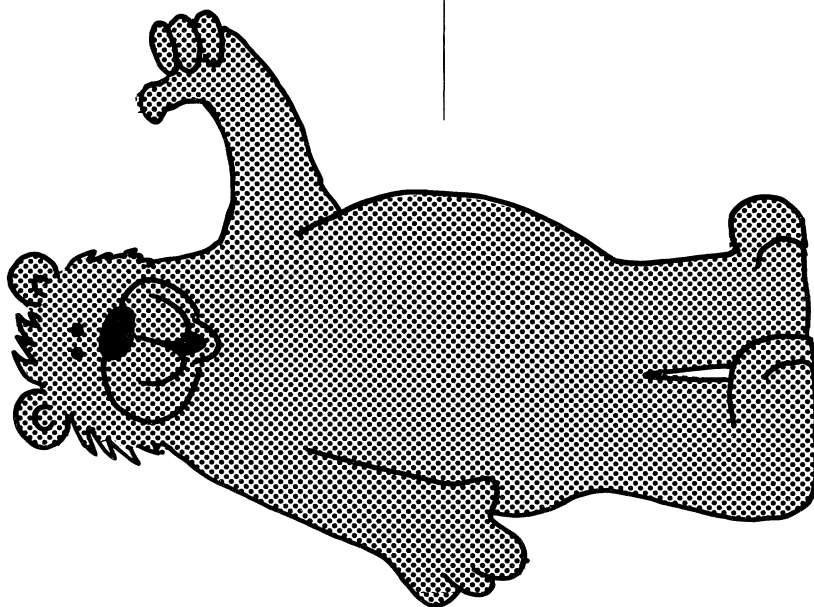

Jungleland Train Trip

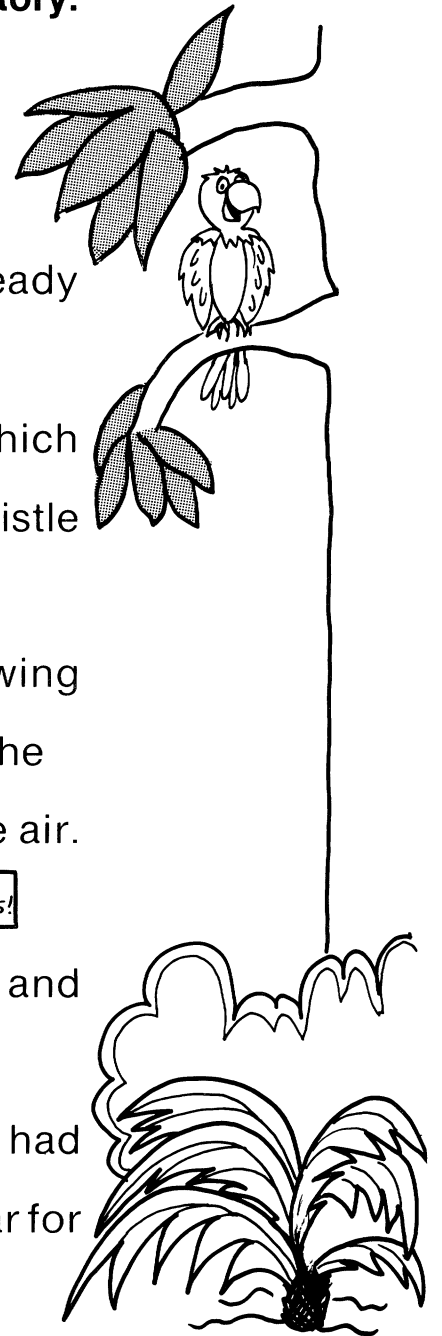
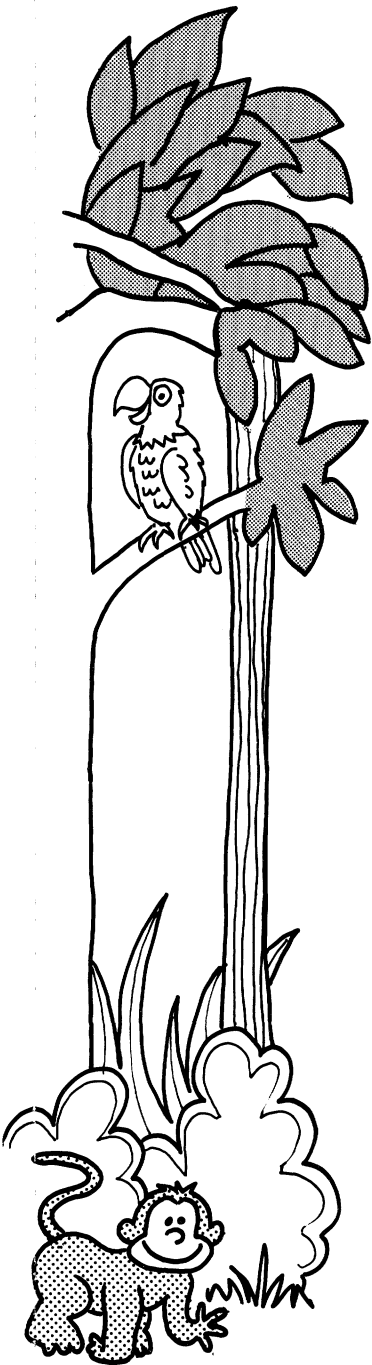
The crew of the zoo train was ready to take us on a trip to Jungleland.

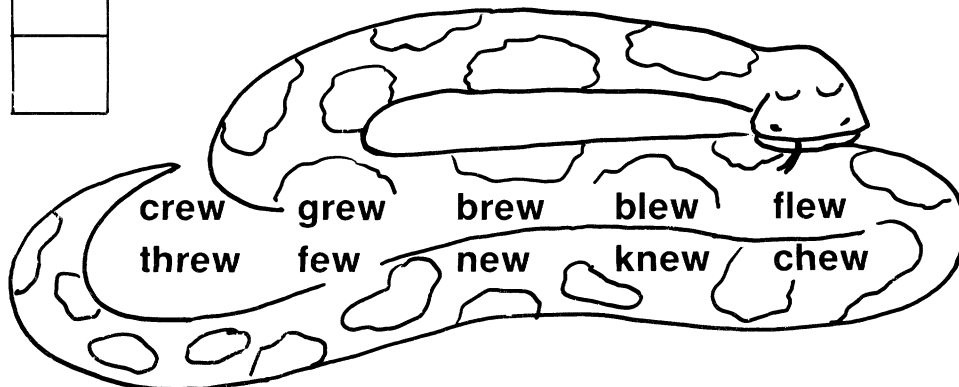

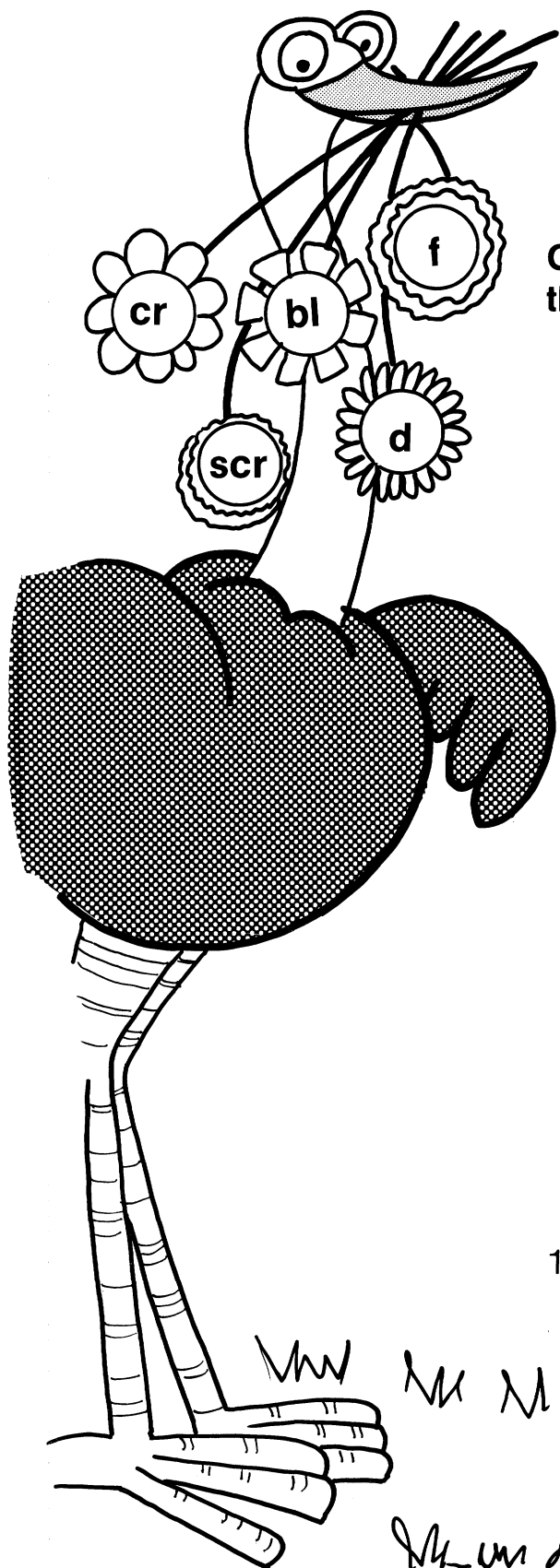
